

The third annual Jackass Dash (Burro Run) is scheduled to be hosted this Saturday, Oct. 14, starting on Main Street in downtown Superior. Residents can expect burros to start arriving at the Box 8 Guest Ranch on Friday for official check ins and vet checks of the animals. For those wishing to watch the burros and runners take off, it is recommended to be on Main Street between 7 a.m. and 7:45 a.m. to meet burros and runners as the race begins at 8 a.m. You can also possibly catch runners on the LOST trail through the US 60 park and Panther Drive areas.

Residents are asked to keep their dogs secured as burros







and dogs are not a good a combination and it is not recommended to bring dogs to the festival.

Following the race start, there will be entertainment, food booths and vendors along with the Farm to Fantastic Market happening downtown. New this year is a stick donkey rodeo. Everyone is encouraged to test their skill at riding a stick donkey. Local crafters in Superior have been making custom stick donkeys for the event.

The event is scheduled to conclude around 5 p.m.



Recent weather-related events combined with the high demand for energy resources have increased power market rates. Because purchased power costs are in part determined by market rates that are not under our control, we need to immediately implement the PCA to meet our financial and statutory requirements. 

State of the Town Event – The Superior Resolve

Rebuild Superior Inc. with the support of many sponsors hosted the third annual State of the Town event last week. The annual event is a celebration of the accomplishments of the Town of Superior and the community as a whole.

The evening event took place at the Besich Park with a reception catered by Felicia's Ice Cream shop, performances by the Superior Dance Company, and awards for community volunteers. Rebuild Superior Inc. Chairman Manny Guzman emceed the event and presented community awards to Billie Jo Villaverde for keeping the tradition of folklorico dancing alive in Superior. Valarie Garcia Denogean was also presented with an award for her constant work with the Youth of Superior and leading the Town of Superior Youth Council.

Lynne Nemeth, the Executive Director of the Boyce Thompson Arboretum, gave a few words about the relationship of the Boyce Thompson Arboretum and the Town of Superior. She highlighted the upcoming centennial celebration activities at the Arboretum. Nemeth announced her resignation a few months ago from the Arboretum. Mayor Mila Besich surprised Nemeth with a presentation of a ceremonial key to the Town.

"Under Lynne's leadership, our relationship with the Boyce Thompson Arboretum has improved greatly. She has lead through the Telegraph fire, massive flooding and a pandemic, all while forging a greatly improved relationship with the Town. We will miss her and leadership and she is deserving of this award," said Mayor Besich.

This year the theme for the event was "The Superior Resolve." Mayor Besich's remarks talked of the accomplishments for the year. Key highlights include reducing the Highway User Revenue Fund imbalance from \$3 million to under a million dollars. She explained that the town will process \$24 million in federal and state grant funding going to a variety of projects across the town including the \$4.5 million wastewater treatment plant upgrade, multi-gen center renovations, and fire breaks. She shared that the baseline of the accomplishments made by the town are measured from where the Town was in 2016 and where it is today.

"Our narrative has shifted dramatically, from broke, boarded-up and blighted, to bright, bodacious and buoyant!" she said.

Besich remarked that the Town is still awaiting the rerelease of the Resolution Copper project's Environmental Impact Statement and shared that there is growing frustration on the delays.

"After eight years of study, consultations primarily with tribes and other stakeholder groups, the re-release of the Resolution Copper Final Environmental Impact Statement continues to be stalled. From our vantage point, it is extremely concerning that we are still waiting on this federal permit especially at a time when our country needs to develop more green energy using American minerals," she said.

Besich also recognized the many entities who helped to create the "Good Neighbor Agreement" to ensure that there is accountability with Resolution Copper now and into the future.

Throughout her remarks, she thanked the staff and many community volunteers.

"I truly appreciate the support and determination of our Council to serve and our staff for their willingness to think big and plan with a laser focus. This dynamic team is a once-in-a-generation team of people committed to Superior – together we have been punching well above our weight class to GSD – get stuff done!" she said.

The evening closed with a final presentation by Superior Dance Company.

The annual event drew about 200 people to the park to learn about the Superior Resolve.
