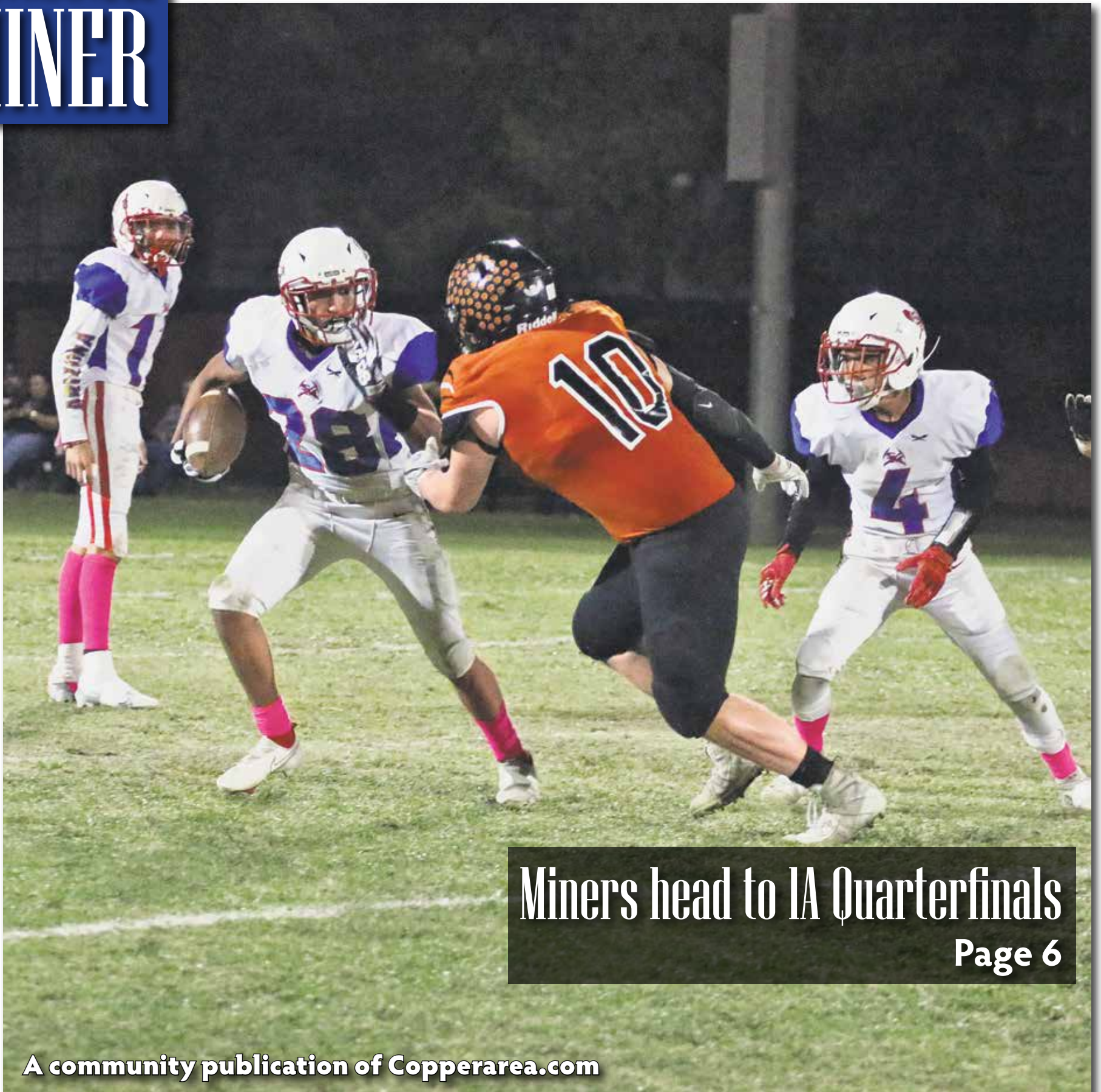
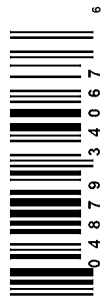

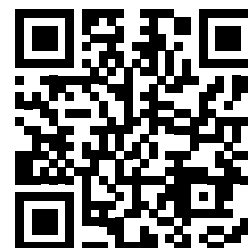

every game the same, study film and work on our timing," stated coach Ernie Ivy.

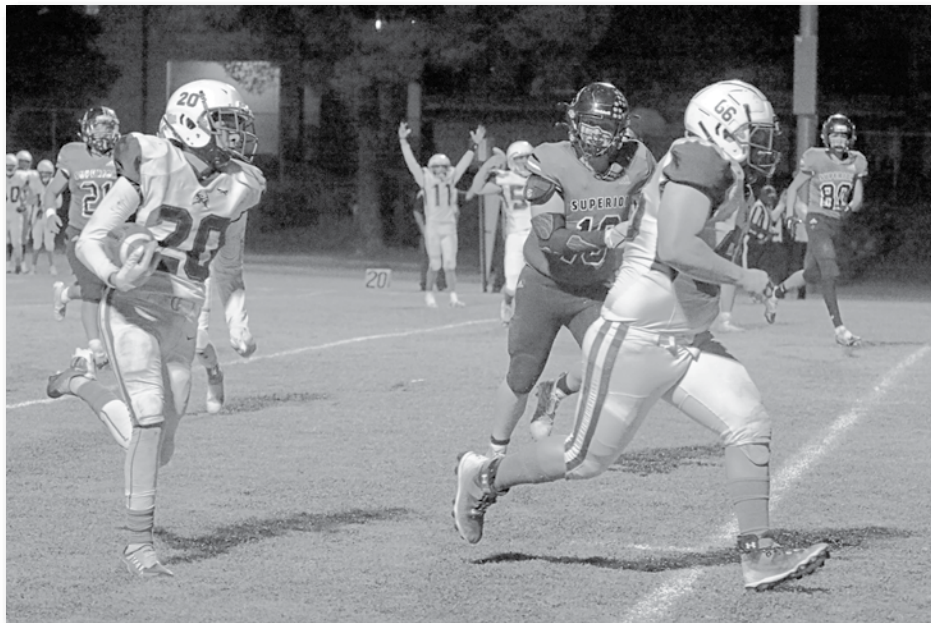
"Hats off to San Manuel. Their coaches had a great game-plan, and their boys executed well," said Superior head coach Joshua Denhalter.

Dia De Los Muertos: Experience the Day of the Dead

Dia de los Muertos, or Day of the Dead in English, is a traditional joyful Mexican celebration centered around a general time frame of the end of October through the beginning of November. Historically, Nov. 1 and 2, are the days concerned to be original for the celebration but other days are often targeted in varied localities.

It is a time to remember the dead, literally. Stories will be told, often with humor, ofrendas will be built for favorite foods and beverages of the dearly departed, graves will be visited and more, to celebrate those missed. Also, for those still here, there is often a focus toward remembering them in the now, with mock epitaphs, gifts and with the best gift, listening to their stories told.

While this is traditionally Mexican, there are very similar celebrations in other cultures in Europe and varied forms of remembering the dead in celebration throughout the world. Many historians note an evolution of Dias de los Muertos with influences coming from Celtic, Roman and Christian influence.

There are those who believe the celebration is fairly new and others who believe that it is a continued tradition from the time of the Aztecs who dedicated an entire month to remembering the dead.

This year, in Oracle there will be a celebration of Dia de los Muertos that will begin with setting up ofrendas on Friday, Nov. 4, from 2 p.m. through 7 p.m. This will be a competition with display and voting on Saturday, Nov. 5, from 11 a.m. through 7 p.m.

There will also be a parade on Friday, Nov. 5, starting at 4 p.m. at the ramada at St. Helen's Parish, where there will be face painting. At 5:30 p.m., the parade moves from St. Helen's to the Oracle Cemetery and ends at the Oracle Community Center where there will be refreshments, a drum circle and Ofrenda competition.

Ofrendas hold offerings of candy skulls, skeletons, sweet bread of the dead, known as pan de muerto, and the favorite foods and drinks of the particular loved one remembered. Marigolds, known as "flower of the dead", which may be combined with other fragrant flowers, are used to make paths to show the souls of the departed
