



The boys' record now sits at 5-2, with a 5-win streak.







Because purchased power costs are in part determined by market rates that are not under our control, we need to immediately implement the PCA to meet our financial and statutory requirements. We will continue to monitor energy rates and adjust the PCA as needed.

Hayden Library hosts class on composting

Because What You've Got is Not Waste. Clean Up Your Act. Compost. Compost On Your Mind? Don't Burn Our Future. Don't Let Anyone Else Give You Crap. Feed the Soil. Greening the Hill. It's Easy to Do. Let's Talk Dirty. Making a Clean Scene. Mother Nature Recycles. Nature's Way to Grow. Reuse Stuff. Reuse Whatever You Can. Reuse, Reduce and Recycle. Smells Like Green Spirit. So Hot Right Now. Too Good to Waste. No matter the slogan, there is one thing that is undeniable: Composting is good for the environment. Chris Jones from the University of Arizona's Cooperative Extension visited the Hayden Library last Friday to talk

about composting.

We know. It's not really glamorous. In fact, it's actually kind of messy. Jones told those present how to start a compost pile. He talked about the materials and construction of the box to contain it. He also spoke extensively about what you can put into a compost pile. And what you can't put into one. The ratio is 30 parts carbon (which includes dried leaves, newspaper, sawdust, etc.) to one part nitrogen (lawn clippings, non meat food scraps, coffee grounds, etc.). The things you're composting should be in layers, and be turned and watered regularly. If it starts smelling like ammonia, it has too much nitrogen. If it's too cold or hot, that's a problem too. The pile should, ideally, be between 90 to 140 degrees F. If it's too hot, that means you need turn the pile, which means getting a shovel and scooping it so the inside is now on the outside, and air is getting in. If it's too cold, then you either need to water it or add more "nitrogen".
