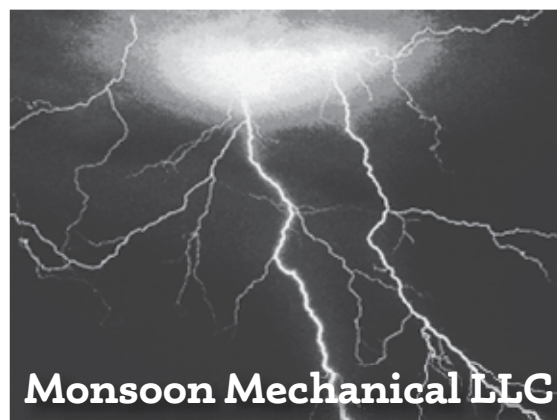
Superior to host second annual State of the Town event Thursday

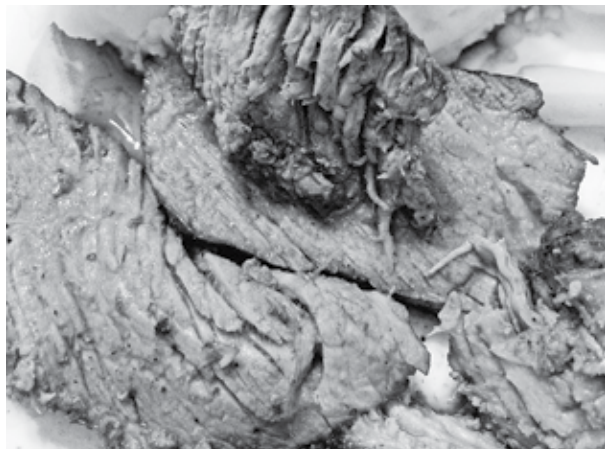

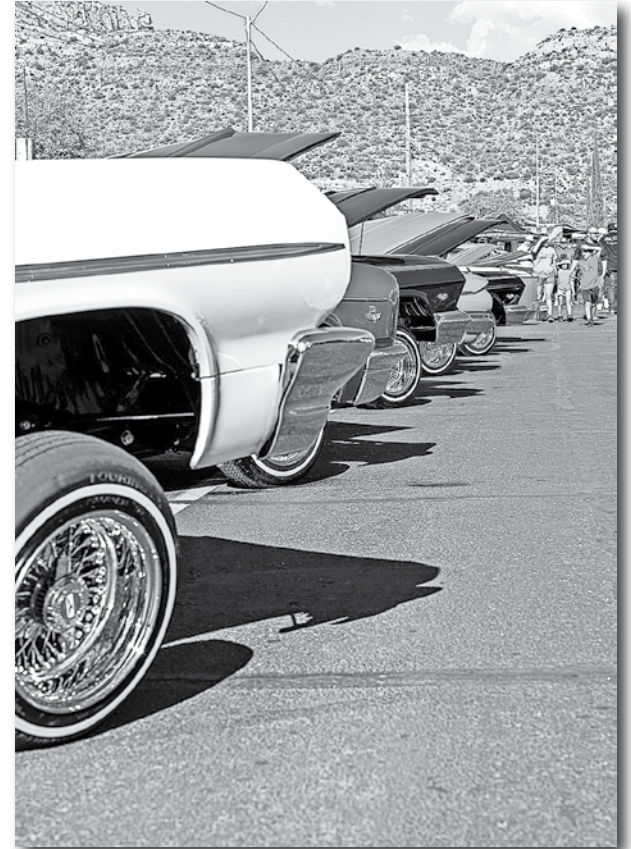
