# Save Rural Arizona Voting Power

Every 10 years, mostly ignored by the major media, every voting district of every state in the country is redrawn. A new Census means new population and demographic numbers. These new numbers make us redraw our voting districts. Voting districts must have equal population, not section off groups deemed "minorities" under federal law and realign like communities.

However, there is one minority group in the State of Arizona that is not protected by law, and too often gets trampled on during "redistricting". That minority group is the rural citizens of Arizona. When metropolitan centers like Phoenix and Tucson are excluded, and urban population centers such as Flagstaff, Sedona, Prescott, San Tan Valley, Casa Grande, and Sierra Vista

are removed, the rural towns and neighborhoods equal less than 25 percent of the total state population.

Our mayors and councilmembers and many of our county supervisors know the struggles of competing against metropolitan areas for a share of the revenues and resources. Besides our local elected officials, there

are no laws protecting our people group. We produce the wealth of the world in minerals, crops, and cattle, yet we fight and labor for what we have. We have ourselves. It is up to us to make sure that our rural voice and voting power is returned to our state government.

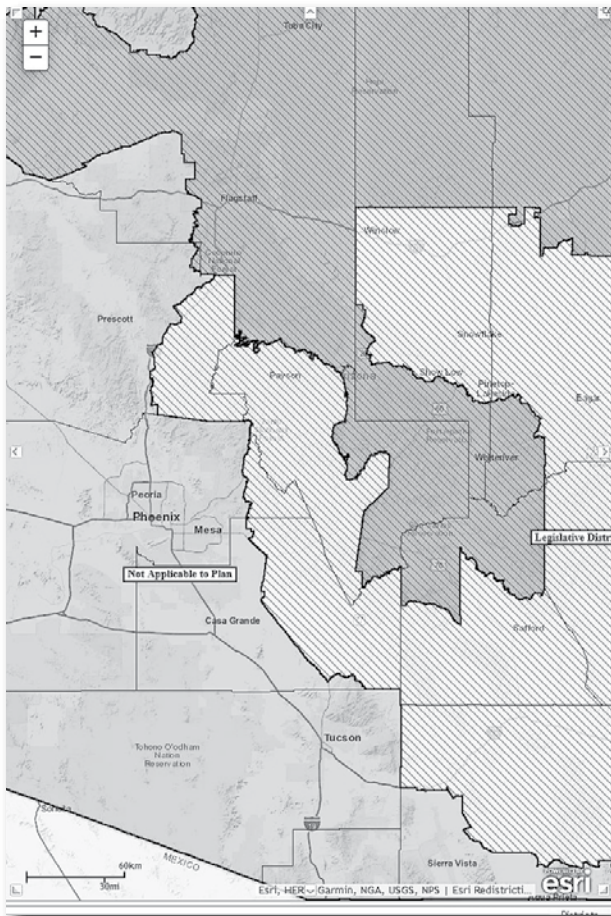

# Pinal Board of Supervisors appoints replacement to Rep. Pratt's seat

Last week, the Pinal County Board of Supervisors met to appoint replacements for two legislative seats for Legislative Districts 8 and 11. The task was left to the Pinal County Board of Supervisors after the death of former Rep. Frank Pratt left a vacancy in LD 8 and the resignation of former Rep. Brett Roberts from LD 11. Both districts represent two different counties, state law requires the Board of Supervisors from the County of the Representative home of record select the replacement.

Neal Carter, a lawyer and small business owner from San Tan Valley, was appointed to fill the Legislative District 8 vacancy. He ran in the 2020 election and lost by a small margin to Rep. David Cook. Carter has spent time in the Copper Corridor and plans to use the next few weeks before the 2022 session starts to catching up with local leaders across the district.

He is licensed as a lawyer in Arizona, holding a Juris Doctor from New York University School of Law and a B.A. from UCLA. Neal's extensive local community involvement includes acting as general counsel for both the Pinal County Republican Committee and for the San Tan Valley Advisory Council.

Additionally, Neal volunteers with Compassion Queen Creek, as well as for veterans organizations, Pinal County's 'Adopt-a-Road' program, and with his church, including at the prisons in Florence.

"I am humbled to step into the shoes of the late Frank Pratt, shoes which really can't be filled. Thank you to the Board of Supervisors for their vote of confidence. Serving as your state representative is a position of sacred trust, and it is my commitment to serve the people of District 8 with as much diligence as I can to live up to that trust," said Carter in a recent press release.

LD 8 is comprised of communities from Pinal County and Southern Gila County, including the Copper Corridor communities of Globe, Miami, Kearny, Mammoth, Oracle, San Manuel, Hayden, Winkelman and Superior. The district also includes parts of Casa Grande, Coolidge, Florence, Eloy and portions of San Tan Valley. Former Rep. Pratt was a resident and business owner in Casa Grande.

The Board also appointed Theresa Martinez to the LD 11 position following the resignation of the former Rep. Brett Roberts. LD 11 consists of the communities of Maricopa, portions of Casa Grande, Arizona City, Red Rock, SaddleBrooke, a portion of Pima County and North Tucson.

Teresa is a lifelong resident of Casa Grande, Arizona and has been involved with the Pinal County Republican Party since 2002 and has worked for Congressman Paul Gosar since 2004, where she serves as Director of Coalitions and Hispanic Outreach. In previous roles, she has worked for Secretary of State Michele Reagan and Congressman Rick Renzi.

Teresa Martinez said of her appointment, "I want to take this opportunity to thank the members of the Pinal County Board of Supervisors for their hard work and commitment to fulfill the representation for State District 11. It is with great honor and privilege to be selected to fulfill the term of Brett Roberts and represent the great people of this district. We are in a very fragile time in our state which I intend to face head-on. I am a believer that hard work and conservative principles are still a

guiding light to success for our great state."

Pinal County Board of Supervisors Chairman Steve Miller commented: "I want to thank all six candidates we interviewed for putting themselves forward, it was a highly competitive process, and all six candidates presented well. Congratulations to both Neal and Teresa, and we look forward to working with and supporting them in any way that we can in their new roles."

Both will fill the remainder of their predecessor's terms which will end in December 2022.

Recently, State and National media have reported an increase in positive COVID-19 Cases. The communities of the Copper Corridor have also started to see an increase in positive cases. The new Delta variant of COVID-19 has been reported as highly transmissible. The CDC and other health officials warn that those who are not vaccinated should continue to practice physical distancing, wear masks in public and avoid crowded places and is also strongly recommending everyone wear a mask indoors and in group settings.

Governor Doug Ducey has signed executive orders that prohibit Cities and Towns from mandating mask wearing, limiting restaurant capacity or other enacting other physical distancing requirements. At this time there is no indication that there will be any restrictions put into place. Local schools are also prohibited from requiring masks be worn on campus.

COVID Vaccines are readily available at local clinics in the region including Cobre Valley Clinics in Superior and Kearny, Pinal County Public Health and Sun Life Clinics. Other chain pharmacies such as Walgreens, grocery story pharmacies and CVS also have vaccines available.

We last reported daily COVID-19 case increased on Oct. 27, 2021. Above is a chart showing our last reported number and the current number of total cases for each of the Copper Corridor communities through Nov. 1, 2021. Keep in mind that zip code data also includes unincorporated areas around a community. For instance, Riverside/Kelvin area is included in the Kearny zip code. Aravaipa and Dudleyville are included in the Winkelman zip codes, etc.

Those experiencing COVID-19 symptoms should seek testing and quarantine until they can confirm a negative test.

**Working together, we can slow the spread of the virus across the Copper Corridor. Wear a mask in public, remain physically distant (6ft apart or more), practice good hygiene (wash your hands frequently, sanitize high touch areas) and stay home if you are not feeling well.**

## Arizona Association for Economic Development honors economic development champion Tim Kanavel with William Lampkin Award and Memorial Scholarship

(PHOENIX – Oct. 28, 2021) – The Arizona Association for Economic Development (AAED) has awarded the William Lampkin Award for Long Term Excellence posthumously to Tim Kanavel, former economic development director for Pinal County. The award was presented at the Economic Development Distinguished by Excellence (EDDE) Award Ceremony held during the organization's annual Fall Forum held in Flagstaff earlier this week.

This award recognizes outstanding achievements by an individual that has made significant contributions to economic development efforts in Arizona and demonstrated a sustained commitment to AAED. Nominations are evaluated based on the overall economic impact of the individual's efforts to Arizona, contributions of the nominee to AAED, the development of strong relationships and community support, and contributions to the economic development profession.

Kanavel was a member of AAED for 20 years, serving on the Board of Directors and chairing the Rural Economic Development Committee. He joined Pinal County in 2009 to create the county's first economic development department.

Kanavel's passion for economic development was evident as he was involved with various economic development initiatives throughout Arizona during his illustrious career. In 2010, he was appointed to the Arizona Governor's Rural Business

Advisory Council where he managed a grant budget of more than \$2.5 million in two of the four years there. He also served on the Board of Directors for the Pinal Partnership Economic Development Coalition and Arizona@Work and served as a member of the Copper Corridor Economic Development Coalition, Pinal Alliance for Economic Growth, Pinal County Industrial Development Authority and Central Arizona Association of Governments. Kanavel passed away in February 2021.

According to Richard Wilkie, economic development director of Casa Grande, Kanavel was a strong proponent of education and professional development. As such, the AAED Board established the Tim Kanavel Memorial Scholarship Fund in his memory, to provide financial assistance to economic developers across the state to pursue their Arizona Economic Development Professional (AZED Pro) certification through AAED.

"Tim always encouraged his staff to participate in AAED programs and events and to avail themselves of the many continuing education opportunities. This a fitting legacy and one that I know Tim would be very proud of," said Stephanie Maack, economic development program manager at Pinal County.

Kanavel's wife and sons were in attendance. His son, David, accepted the award on behalf of his father.

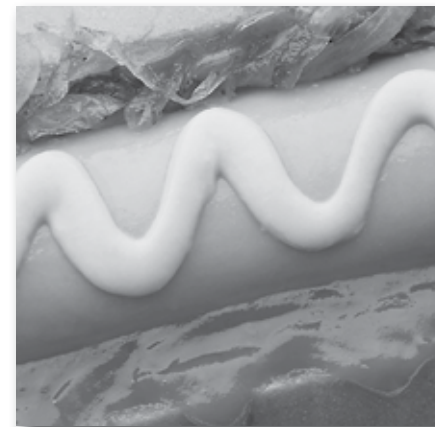
