



The Superior High School Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA) have announced that they will host their 9th annual Fill-A-Bowl Fundraiser for the Superior Food Bank. The event is scheduled for Friday, Nov. 17, 2023, at the Superior Junior-Senior High School Multi-Purpose room.

Tickets are \$12 per person and includes all-you-can eat soup and salad dinner with drinks and desert and a custom decorated bowl. The dinner will begin at 6 p.m. Tickets need to pre-purchased at the Superior Junior Senior High School or by contacting any member of the Superior High School FBLA.

Superior is not exempt from the concerns of and impacts of food insecurity. The event is also an opportunity to educate others on food insecurity. According to Feeding America, 44 million people, including 13 million children experience food insecurity. The Superior Food Bank provides food to 15 percent of Superior's population. Inflation and other economic uncertainty has increased the number of people needing food from the Superior Food Bank. Food insecurity can cause health problems, especially when people are having to choose between medicine or food. Long term food instability also creates problems for young children. Without proper nutrition, brain function and development can be impacted.

In addition to helping to educate others on food insecurity and raising money for the Superior Food Bank, these young future business leaders plan, market and coordinate the entire event. The planning of the event teaches critical business lessons in marketing, project management, cost analysis and customer service. These students then compete at the regional and state level competitions, sharing the skills they learned working on the project along with other skills they can demonstrate during various competitions.

FBLA is a program of the Superior High School and is considered a Career Technical Education (CTE) program supported by the Cobre Valley Institute of Technology (CVIT).



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Hayden heads into the Championship game with win over El Capitan

The night air was crisp, and the stadium lights of Ed Anderson field in Scottsdale were bright on Friday, Nov. 3, as the Lobos prepared to take the field for the 1A state semifinals playoff game against El Capitan. The Hayden community came out strong, showing up to support their boys, because, as the saying goes, it takes a village. A loud and proud sea of Lobo blue overtook the bleachers.

The Lobos took to the field energized as Mark Acevedo lead the team carrying a blue flag baring an H with Lobos written underneath it. After the captains met for the coin flip, it was decided that the Lobos would kick off first. Mj Oropeza kicked the starting kickoff, sending the ball down the field. During the first plays of the game, the Eagles threw and completed a lot of passes, before being stopped by Lobo defense. As the Eagles kept gaining yards by passes, Tyler Garner intercepted a pass, giving the ball to the Lobos. Deondre Collier did some solid running, gaining some yards for them. The boys were looking for a touchdown, and trying to break past El Capitan's tough defense. Kino Lorona helped gain yards for the Lobos while back on defense, catching solid passes. The first quarter went back and forth like a battle, and ended with a o-o score.

During the start of the second quarter, the ball was in Hayden's hands. Lorona kept displaying Lobo toughness, as he

proved to be a moving force, tough for the Eagles to take down. Paul Gaither scored the first touchdown, running the ball into the end-zone, followed by Collier running in the two-point conversion, setting the score to 8-0, with 9:33 minutes left in the first half. Acevedo played tough defense, going after the quarterback and stopping him from throwing passes. With 1:03 left on the clock, Garner made an interception at the 10 yard line. The first half ended with a 8-o score. The Lobos played a tough first half, stopping the Eagles the closer they'd get to scoring. The boys offense was playing good, but kept getting caught before they could break away and score smoothly.

The second half of the game began with the Eagles giving a short kickoff to the Lobos. The Lobos continued to try and break through a tough defense. The Eagles were able to sneak past the boys and score a touchdown off of a run, followed by a two-point conversion, putting the score at 8-8 early in the third quarter. This marked the re-ignition of the Lobos determination. The boys played an aggressive offense, running head on into the Eagles trying to stop them, usually having to be taken down by multiple players. Keiston Pool caught in end-zone pass, bringing the Lobos up to 14 points with 6:46 left in the third quarter. The Lobos' defense held tight, while the offense kept playing aggressively. The third guarter ended with a 14-8 score. The fourth quarter came, and the Lobos still had gas in the tank. Collier and

Lorona kept propelling the Lobo offense forward. Lorona scored a touchdown, bringing the Lobos to 20 points.

"Smart! Play smart!" coach Estrada velled at the boys on defense. Eric Fox made an interception with 5:27 left on the clock. JJ Manriquez collected a pass, then ran 64 yards for the touchdown, putting the boys at 26, followed by Lorona scoring the two-point conversion, moving the score to 28. The Lobos' defense kept strong, and held the Eagles from scoring, while Lorona continued to intercept their passes.

The game ended with a 28-8 final score, making it a Lobo victory! The boys are

"We are super proud of you guys," began coach Estrada during the post game huddle. "We worked hard to get here, and on Monday we're going to work hard."
