

Roy was preceded in death by his parents and first wife, Margaret Cobb Cline, to whom he was married from 1956 until her death in 1984.


The immediate family will have a ceremony with his ashes in February 2022.







John and Tommy Rhodes inducted into **Rodeo Cowboys Hall of Fame**

Longtime local ranchers and cowboys, John

and Thomas "Tommy" Rhodes, father and son, were posthumously inducted into the Rodeo Cowboys Hall of Fame in

November 2021. John (1887 – 1973) and Thomas (1915 -1981) were known for their roping skills at rodeo events around the country. They were consistent winners of monev at rodeos in Arizona including those at Prescott, Payson, Benson, Phoenix, and the Fiesta de los Vaqueros in Tucson. They were known to dominate roping at the Tucson Rodeo where John last competed at 80 years old. John and Tommy competed at the Cheyenne, Wyoming Frontier Days rodeo, rodeos in California, Reno, Nevada, Boston, Massachusetts and Madison Square Garden in New York City. John was a two-time World Champion Team Roper in 1936 and 1938.

In 1944, he was World **Champion Steer Roper** and, in 1947, a Champion Team Tyer. He spent most of his life in or near Mammoth, Arizona. He owned the YI Ranch from 1917 to 1933 and the Sacaton Ranch from 1933 to 1953.

Thomas was World **Champion Steer Roper** 1943, Champion Team Roper in 1944 and World Champion Team Tyer in 1945 and 1946. He was owner of the WLE Ranch near Mammoth until his death. John and Thomas are both buried at the Valley View Cemetery in Mammoth.

John and Thomas were both original members of the Cowboys' Turtle Association. It was organized in 1936 at the Boston Garden during a rodeo. A group of cowboys

decided to go on strike to protest the low amount of prize money. They asked the promoter to add the cowboy's entry fees to the prize money. He refused but later gave in and the union was born. It would eventually become today's **Professional Rodeo** Cowboys' Association. It was named the Turtle Association because the cowboys had acted so

honor for both men. The National Rodeo Hall of Fame is located at the National Western Heritage Museum in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Author's note: John's mother Mary Ann Tewksbury Rhodes was one of the last survivors of the Graham-Tewksbury range war also known as the Pleasant Valley War. 29 men died during the feud. John's father was John Tewksbury who was murdered at his ranch home by the Graham faction. Mary Ann was 8 1/2 months pregnant with John when she witnessed the killing and survived hours of being shot at inside her home. Tewksbury's friend John Rhodes married Mary Ann and gave John his last name. He brought the family to the San Pedro and Mammoth area working at some of the ranches. John's stepfather and his uncle Ed Tewksbury were charged with murder for the killing of the last Graham brother but were acquitted. You could almost say that John Rhodes was the last survivor of the Pleasant Valley War.

The very next year, many more letters to Santa were printed in the same newspaper. A tradition was born. Though Santa has never explained the reason he started sharing the letters he receives and allows them to be printed, there are many theories which he has equally never denied as possibilities.

The chief theory is that with the increased population of the world, Santa was using this method of communication to seek out new helpers. Another theory, somewhat less likely to apply in all situations, is that the newspaper editor had been a very good boy or girl in their youth and Santa felt they deserved an extra present.
