## Former Mammoth Councilman found deceased following missing person search

The search for missing Mammoth resident Bob Sloan came to a sad end Thursday afternoon when Mammoth Police and members of Pinal County Sheriff's Office Search and Rescue located his body in the desert in Pinal County outside of the Mammoth town limits.

Sloan was reported missing by his family on Tuesday, Feb. 8, after he left his home in the area of Hetzel Avenue to drive to his friend's home. Family members said he left at 11 a.m.

Mammoth Police entered a missing person report and began a search of Mammoth and the surrounding areas. They also contacted Arizona Department of Public Safety which issued a Silver Alert for the 85-year-old man. Mammoth PD acted as a liaison between the Sloan family and law enforcement during the search.

According to Mammoth Police Chief Hank Mueller. a concerned citizen reported to Mammoth Police that they found what they believed to be Sloan's vehicle in Pinal County Jurisdiction just outside of the Town of Mammoth on a primitive road. Mammoth PD immediately responded to the area, located and confirmed the vehicle was indeed Sloan's. Sloan was nowhere to be seen in the immediate area of his vehicle.

The search was turned over to Pinal County

Sheriff's Office Search and Rescue, although Mammoth Police continued to assist in the search under SAR's guidance. An air unit was launched to assist in the search. Shortly after, Sloan's body was located in the desert area by SAR.


"The Mammoth Police officers that were involved were impressive in their work and in their kindness," a member of Sloan's family told the *Miner*. "Boy, they really

liked Dad. He spoke highly of the newer officers."

Sloan served on the Mammoth Town Council and stood as Police Commissioner for a while.

"I did not expect the degree to which (the police) spoke highly, and knowledgeably, of him," the family member added. "It was really touching."

"Mammoth PD would like to express our deepest condolences to Mr. Sloan's family and to our entire community," said Chief

# Public comments sought on changes to Air Force training areas

The Copper Corridor region is used to playing a large role in the practice and training of both US and Arizona air troops. It is not uncommon to see several Air Force jets flying in formation or hearing the jets whiz by over your head on a walk or even an occasional and accidental sonic boom will rock your house. Authorities believe that the Telegraph and Mescal forest fires this summer may have been started by flares that did not extinguish before hitting the ground.

Leaders and land managers that are in the Outlaw, Jackal, Morenci and Reserve Military Operations Areas (MOAs) were notified that the Air Force had filed an Environmental Impact Statement that was subsequently published in the Federal Register. An Environmental Impact Statement is a series of studies and public comment period which helps to evaluate if the requested actions by a company or government entity would affect public lands, animals, or humans.


On Tuesday, Feb. 8, the Air Force hosted a public meeting at the Superior Town Hall, one of seven public hearings that is designed to help the public better understand the process, learn about what the Air Force is requesting and also allow the public to comment on the proposed plans. Comments must be received by March 4.


The majority of the Copper Corridor is affected by these plans as the communities of Superior, Miami, Globe, Kearny and Mammoth are located within the Outlaw MOA, with San Manuel and Oracle just outside of the Outlaw district. The Jackal MOA also covers the mountains and canyons such as the Aravaipa Canyon all the way to Safford.

In the scoping document for the EIS, the Air Force explains that in order to continue to train properly they need to utilize existing military air space more aggressively, as other air spaces are more congested. This will also allow airmen to train and practice closer to their home bases. The air spaces are used primarily by Davis Monthan Air Force Base, Luke Air Force Base and Morris ANGB.

According to their website, the MOAs that are currently used for Air Force training in Arizona, specifically low altitude airspace




## Miners compete in 2022 Wrestling Sectional Tournament; four qualify for state championships

The Thatcher High School Gym was packed with wrestlers and spectators on Saturday, Feb. 12. Among the crowd was the San Manuel Wrestling team, ready to compete in the 2022 Wrestling Sectional Tournament for Division IV, Section IV. Two mats lay in the center of the gym, with wrestling going by weight classes. The first two rounds of the tournament saw both wins and losses for the Miners.

With the rounds proceeding, the wrestlers with medaling opportunities grew shorter. By the time of the final round, only four Miners were left wrestling. Those four were Raymond Garcia, Jakob Tafoya, Aiden Lozoya, and Aedon Hawkins, all wrestling for third place. Garcia had a tough match; down in points by the third period, he was able to tie it up, but his Mica Mountain opponent was able to score two near-fall points in the final seconds of the third round. Garcia lost 3-5, giving him the fourth place medal for the 113-lb weight class.

Jakob Tafoya also found himself wrestling against Mica Mountain. Tafoya found himself going back and forth with his opponent, trading control of the match. At the end of the third period the scoreboard read 5-5, sending the wrestlers into overtime, the first wrestler to get a takedown would win. The wrestlers

circled and looked for their openings, and in the end, Tafoya was able to get the final takedown, winning 7-5. Tafoya placed third for the 144-lb weight class.

Aiden Lozoya faced off against Thatcher for the second time that day in the finals. The match started off slow, but Lozoya eventually found control, and was the only one to put points onto the board for the match. During the third period, Lozoya was able to once again pin the wrestler from Thatcher, securing the third place medal for the 215-lb weight class.

Aedon Hawkins closed out the night, being one of the last matches. Hawkins put up a tough fight, but wasn't able to defeat his Benson competitor. Hawkins lost by fall in the second period, giving him the fourth place medal at the 285-lb weight class.

"We qualified four out of nine Miner Wrestlers to the state tournament. We fell short of our goal, but we gave it everything we had. I'm very proud of our team effort," stated head coach Daniel Najera, "Our sectional tournament is a gauntlet and coming out of it prepares us for state. We have to dial it in this week and clean up some positions. We will be ready for next weekend."

On Feb. 18-19, the four qualified Miner Wrestlers will compete at the Division IV State Championships at the Phoenix Veterans Memorial Coliseum.

and airspace that supports supersonic operations at low altitude, have become saturated with aircraft. While the Air Force manages an extensive network of valuable SUA in the region, including the restricted areas associated with the Barry M. Goldwater Range, the volume and attributes associated with the individual MOA are insufficient to meet the current training requirements. The Air Force is proposing a regional approach that aims at optimizing the existing training airspace to meet current and future mission requirements of multiple users. The airspace proposed for optimization includes the following MOAs: Tombstone, Outlaw, Jackal, Reserve, Morenci, Bagdad, Gladden, Sells, Ruby, and Fuzzy. These MOAs overlie land located throughout southern Arizona and a small portion of western New Mexico.

Specifically for the Outlaw and Jackal MOAs, their requested changes would include: flights being operated from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Friday. Currently they are allowed to fly until 6 p.m. and from 6 to 10 p.m. but only with certain permissions via NOTEM. They are also requesting to drop flares at 500 feet in elevation. They are also requesting permission to lower the elevation where flares can be released and also lower the elevation

of supersonic flying.

There are also three additional public hearings: Feb. 22 in Reserve, New Mexico, at Village Hall; Feb. 23 in Morenci at the Clifton Community Center; and on Feb. 24 in Animas, New Mexico at the Animas High School. All of these hearings are scheduled from 5 to 7 p.m.

Once the public scoping period is over, comments will be categorized and the concerns will be studied and evaluated by a private organization that specializes in these type of studies. Once the study is complete, a Draft Environmental Impact Statement will be released and there will be an additional review and comment period. Once those comments are reviewed a Final EIS will be released and a Record of Decision will be signed. It is not expected that this process will be complete until 2024.

## Pinal County redistricting will break up Copper Corridor

Every 10 years, Pinal County is required to conduct a redistricting process that ensures each County Supervisor district has an equal number of residents per district. In the process, they must also consider the connectivity and congruent connection of the district. The process must also avoid separating municipal communities and should try to avoid having incumbent candidates running against each other.

For many years, District One included eastern Pinal County, Eloy, Florence and Coolidge. During the 2010 redistricting process two additional Supervisor districts were added to balance the number of residents per district. Declining population in the Copper Corridor is affecting the ability to keep the mining communities of Superior, Kearny, Mammoth, San Manuel and Oracle together. Collectively, this part of the Pinal County is known as the Copper Corridor.

Pinal County staff has presented two options for the Board of Supervisors to vote on. Prior to the Board of Supervisors voting on final maps, there are a series of community input listening sessions. Both proposals will chop up the eastern portion of the County.

Plan A proposes that Superior join a district with Apache Junction, Gold Canyon, Queen Valley, Top of the World and a small portion of unincorporated population north of the San Tan Valley Area. This district would be known as District 5. Kearny, Mammoth, Aravaipa, San Manuel, Mammoth and Oracle would remain in District 1 with this district also including Florence and Coolidge, along with all the

unincorporated areas in between. The communities south of Oracle including SaddleBrooke, Marana and Red Rock will remain in District 4.


Plan B proposes that Superior and Kearny join District 5, which would also include a small portion of prison population in Florence, Apache Junction, Queen Valley, Gold Canyon, Top of the World and a small area north of San Tan Valley.

The Copper Corridor communities historically have been in one Supervisor District which helps to maintain interest among like communities. Both plans will place communities of the Copper Corridor into districts where they will be combined with much larger and more urban districts.

Residents of Pinal County are urged to participate in the public comments. There

will be a public hearing in San Manuel on Thursday, Feb. 17, at the San Manuel Community Center from 6 to 7 p.m. The community center is located at 111 W. 5th Avenue. Following the community outreach events, the Pinal County Board of Supervisors will vote on a final redistricting map. The Board of Supervisors are expected to vote on the final maps in early March. The redistricting will not take affect until the next election in 2024. This will allow for voters to either vote for incumbent or another candidate.
