Pinal County Public Hearing on the use of HUD program funding
The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires Pinal
County to publish a five-year consolidated plan and annual action plans outlining
the use of funds for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home
Investment Partnership (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) programs.
All Pinal County citizens are invited to voice their comments regarding housing and
community development needs, strategies to meet identified needs, and identifying

barriers to those needs. Public input is an essential component of this planning effort.

The Pinal County Board of Supervisors, in conjunction with the cities and towns of Eloy, Florence, Mammoth and Maricopa would like to invite all members of the public to a public hearing on March 16, 2022 at 9:30am. The public hearing is to review proposed projects and solicit ideas for additional projects.

Eligible projects must meet a national objective under the CDBG program. Sample projects include: community facility improvements including park facilities; public infrastructure including water, sewer, roads, sidewalks, and ADA accessibility; housing rehabilitation; and public services.

For the FY2022, Pinal County will receive an estimated CDBG allocation of \$1,800,000, an estimated HOME allocation of \$620,000, and an estimated ESG allocation of \$160,000. The four participating cities and towns may receive funding under the CDBG allocation based on their submitted applications.

CVRMC builds new facility in Kearny

The pandemic has been a huge reminder to everyone, how important local and accessible health care really is. Traveling out of town for routine health care is not always easy and in many cases it is often cost prohibitive for many residents.

The Cobre Valley Regional Medical Center

has announced that it will be building a new medical facility to serve the residents of the Copper Basin. When the Kearny Hospital closed many years ago, the Copper Area Health Volunteers raised funds to keep the old hospital building in shape to have a health care providers visit the community. A few years ago, CVRMC joined forces with the Volunteers and purchased the property.
