aste Management of Arizona is squeezing
Oracle residents once again. And a day after
Pinal County Supervisor Jeff McClure reported
that it's "still in the hands of the corporate powers that be"
residents are being slapped with a \$15 per load fee. Mary
Ellen Kazda (Kaz) suggested in an email to our Supervisor
Jeffrey McClure that she thought he was one of "the
powers that be". He responded he would be but BOS does
not have any control over the affairs of a publicly operated
business. So does no "control" mean no contract with the
county and WM can do whatever it wants?

Two Waste Management workers report via a reliable local source that it's Pinal County's decision (meaning

the Board of Supervisors on which Jeff McClure sits) to impose the new fees. This, of course, directly contradicts McClure's claim.

Just to review: Move one by Waste Management/ Pinal County was to cut the number of cherished dump vouchers from 6 to 3. Move two as of Monday, March 6 is to impose \$15 per load assessment fee.

The bottom line here is that taken together Oracle residents are on the receiving end of a big financial hit. Some old timers will recall that when Pinal County turned the Oracle landfill over to Waste Management to serve as a "transfer station" a contract was signed that included negotiated terms. The Pinal County Board of

Supervisors was a party to that and subsequent contracts with Waste Management of Arizona.

We don't know what the current status of that contract is. We've asked both Supervisor McClure and County Manager Lew for specifics but to date none have been forthcoming. Yet the fees are set to go into effect this Monday, March 6.

Supervisor McClure will hold a "Meet and Greet" along with the Pinal County Recorder's Office on Thursday, March 9, with an "open house" format between 1 and 2 p.m. at the Oracle Community Center, 685 E. American Ave., Oracle AZ 85623.

Sen. Sinema visits with local elected leaders

Senator Krysten Sinema visited the Copper Corridor region on Friday afternoon. Arizona's Senior Senator has recently began a series of rural roundtable sessions to discuss the needs of rural Arizona.

During the session, held at the Globe-Miami Chamber of Commerce, Sinema shared that she wanted to return to hosting regular sessions with rural leaders across the state. During the early days of the COVID-19 Pandemic, Sinema hosted weekly calls with leaders across the state to keep them informed and provide up-to-date information. Her intention to is to host these calls and in-person

session again to ensure that rural leaders are aware of programs and services at the federal level.

In attendance at the meeting were Gila County Supervisors Woody Cline and Tim Humphries. Mayor Angel Medina, Miami, Mayor Curtis Stacy, Kearny, Mayor Bobby Davis, Star Valley, Mayor Chip Wilson, Apache Junction, Mayor Chris Higgins, Payson, Mayor Mila Besich, Superior, and Mayor John Thompson, Coolidge. Pinal County and the City of Globe were represented by staff members.

During the round table meeting, a variety of issues

were discussed: a key point discussed was transportation funding not only for larger road projects like I-10 but also the need for funding for neighborhood streets. Supervisor Woody Cline along with Mayor Davis discussed the needs for veterans. Sinema has been supportive of the development of the Gila County Veterans Retreat center in Young. Another topic discussed was wildfire prevention and the need for funding for post fire support to prevent funding and repair fences used by ranchers. Currently funding available comes with so many restrictions that



Another topic of importance to the region was the need for responsible mining of American minerals. Mayor Besich thanked Sinema for her support of the Resolution Copper project and expressed frustration that the Federal **Environmental Impact** Statement still has not been re-released. Sinema shared that she has been working with the Arizona Manufacturing and Defense Council to identify areas in Arizona where critical minerals can be mined.


ended the tournament with a game against Ray, where they received their third loss, with a 5-10 final score.
