Mildred 'Midge' Bryant Cole

Mildred "Midge" Bryant Cole (Johnson), 83, passed away on March 25, 2022, in Tucson, Arizona.

Midge was born June 28, 1938, in Pleasant Ridge, Kentucky. In 1945, Midge and her family moved to Globe, Arizona so her older brother could recover from tuberculosis. The family settled in Superior, Arizona where she graduated high school with honors in 1955. Also in 1955, she married Richard Maine, making their home in Superior. She attended ASU graduating with honors, receiving a bachelor's degree in elementary education.

For 16 years she taught in Superior, Globe and Miami. She also received a Reading Specialist Endorsement and master's degree from the University of Arizona.

In 1967, they adopted son Richard "Richie", in 1968 their son Paul was born, followed by Roy in 1969, and John in 1971. In 1973, Midge and Richard divorced making her a single mom to four rambunctious boys.

In 1975, she received her principal's certificate from Arizona State University and was hired as principal of Pitman Elementary School in Holbrook, AZ. In the late 70s, she helped plan and design the new Park Elementary School. She later

earned her superintendent's certificate from Northern Arizona University. She remained a principal until her retirement in 1991, completing 32 years in education. She loved her entire career in education but considered her 16 years in Holbrook as a principal the most rewarding.

Midge was a member of the First Baptist Church in Holbrook serving in many roles and in several teaching positions. She served the longest as a Sunday school teacher for ladies, who like herself, attended church alone. Her focus was using her skills to teach and mentor the ladies in their faith.

Being a single mom raising four active boys by herself was not easy and often proved to be quite challenging. However, she would say that her favorite time in her life was raising her boys in Holbrook.

In 1987, Midge met Jim Cole and married in 1988. Jim was an amazing partner and a true gentleman. In 1991, however, Midge had her greatest setback in life when she lost her 24-year-old son Richie following a year-long illness. Midge and Jim eventually built their dream home in Sonoita, Arizona.

In retirement she served the Sonoita area by volunteering with the Elgin school, Elgin club, fairgrounds, and the VFW. Midge and Jim were founding members of the Sonoita Hills



Investing elevated in the Town of Superior, Arizona

Superior has recently received a total of \$4.25 million appropriation from the federal government for two important projects for the future of this small rural desert community.

Mayor Mila Besich and Councilman Gilbert Aguilar recently returned from a visit to Washington, DC, with the fruits of hard work on the part of the Arizona Congressional delegation to secure funding for the Superior Multi-Gen and Enterprise Center and for the restoration of natural habitat(s) of Queen Creek. In the omnibus bill signed by President Joe Biden on March 15, a total of \$4.25 million was approved for these two projects.

Two million dollars will help fund the Superior Multi-Generational and Enterprise Center. Developing a multigenerational center was a key strategic goal Superior's Town Council set in 2016 to ensure that the Town continues to invest in and expand the community's economic development and quality of life assets. To achieve this overarching goal, the Town purchased the original Superior High School – a local historic treasure. By providing a space for education, health, creativity and culture to flourish, Superior is strengthening a resilient and socially connected community.

"Superior has the potential to grow exponentially in the future. Because of Congressman O'Halleran's leadership and hard work, and that of U.S. Senators Kelly and Sinema to fund our Workforce, Entrepreneurship and Innovation Center, we will be able to grow good, high-paying jobs that will enable our Town to build a stronger, more diverse and sustainable economy. We applaud our Arizona Congressional Delegation for their efforts," said Superior Mayor Mila Besich.

The importance of preservation efforts is multi-fold. Investing in local economies and communities is an important first step, while investing resources in land and water is paramount. For communities in the Southwest U.S., water is the most precious resource of all.




