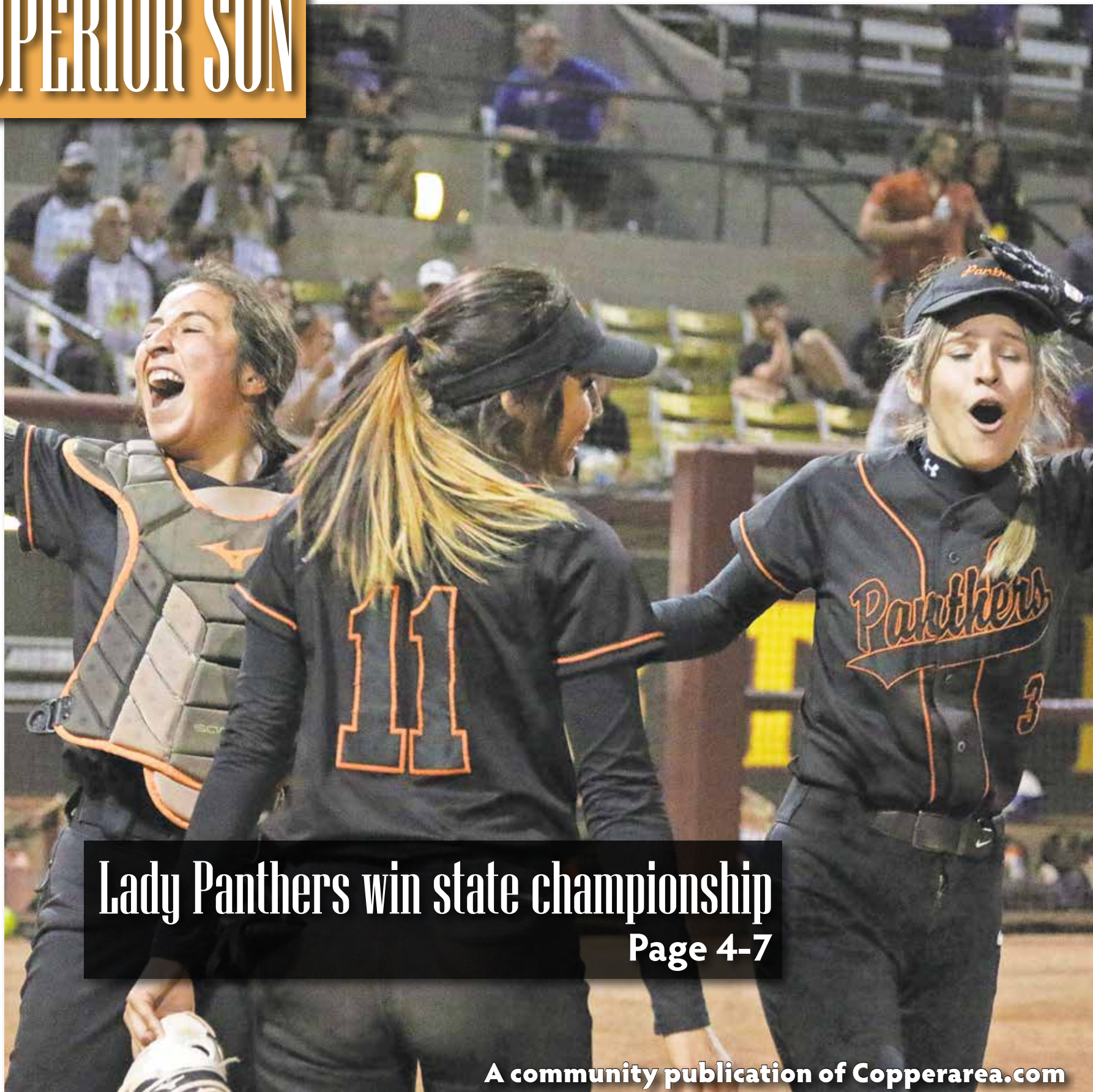


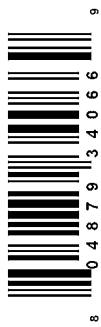

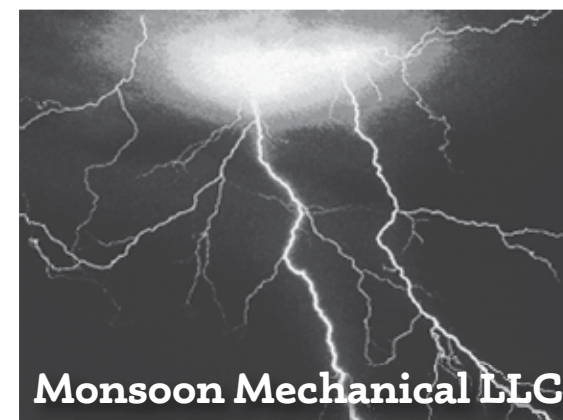

# Air Force announces extended comment period for proposed changes to air space use

Earlier this year, the United States Air Force conducted a series of public hearings and conducted a public scoping comment period for proposed changes to air space use in Arizona including much of the Copper Corridor.

In the scoping document for the EIS, the Air Force explained that in order to continue to train properly they need to utilize existing military air space more aggressively, as other air spaces are more congested. This will also allow airmen to train and practice closer to their home bases. The air spaces are used primarily by Davis Monthan Air Force Base, Luke Air Force Base and Morris ANGB.

The majority of the Copper Corridor is affected by these plans as the communities of Superior, Miami, Globe, Kearny and Mammoth are located within the Outlaw MOA, with San Manuel and Oracle just outside of the Outlaw district. The Jackal MOA also covers the mountains and canyons such as the Aravaipa Canyon all the way to Safford.

Specifically for the Outlaw and Jackal MOAs, their requested changes would include: flights being operated from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Friday. Currently they are allowed to fly until 6 p.m. and from 6 to 10 p.m. but only with certain permissions via NOTEM. They are also requesting to drop flares at 500 feet in elevation. They are also requesting permission to lower the elevation where flares can be released and also lower the elevation of supersonic flying.

The original scoping period closed out on March 4, 2022. Several local municipalities, including the Town of Superior, City of Globe, Town of Miami, Capstone Copper Mining and Resolution Copper submitted comments in the original scoping period.

This past week, the United States Air Force announced that they have extended the comment period and members of the public can provide input and comments through June 3, 2022. Those who have already submitted comments, do not have to resubmit, those comments are currently under review. It is not

uncommon for the comment periods for these federal processes to be extended. Usually the extensions are requested to ensure everyone who needs to make comment has ample time to submit their comments.

As the EIS process continues, those entities and individuals who have submitted comments will have what is called "standing" in the process. This ensures those

# Superior brings home

Who could have guessed that the two best 1A softball teams in the state would be from the Copper Corridor?

The championship all came down to Superior vs. San Manuel.

It was the third state championship for the Panthers and the second since 2015 when Superior beat San Manuel

3-0. The Miners took second place last year to Williams and the program finished with an even 2-2 record against Superior this spring.

San Manuel (19-5) earned the top seed in the 1A ranks and Superior (18-6) earned the No. 2 seed this spring and the bracket played out according to plan with the two

programs meeting on the final night of play.

This would be their fifth game of the season against the Lady Miners. The Lady Panthers held 2 wins and 2 losses against San Manuel for the season.

The championship game started off with San Manuel pulling ahead by 2 runs in the first inning. In the third

inning, the Lady Panthers were able to tie the score by posting 2 runs. The 2-2 stalemate lasted until the fifth inning, where both teams posted 1 run, making it a 3-3 tie. The tie once again continued until the seventh inning, where the Lady Panthers were able to post 3 runs.

Keeping San Manuel from scoring, the girls were able to claim the victory, with a final score of 6-3.

Leading the team from the mound was Danika Bryant, who only allowed 3 runs in the last two games, and struck out 29 batters. Myika Cruz did great at the plate, going 4

for 7 with a double and scoring 4 runs in the two games, helping her team win.

“We had contributions from the entire team. It was truly a team effort,” commented coach Alfonso Lopez. “This
