

# Forecasted hot temperatures, dry thunderstorms – a combination for very high fire danger across Arizona

People in the Copper Corridor are no strangers to the danger of wildfires. This year has already seen four devastating fires (Margo, Simmons, Mescal and Telegraph) and with a fifth one threatening (Pinnacle), now is the time to be cautious.

The forecasted heat wave coupled with an unstable atmosphere and extremely dry fuels have the potential to produce large wildland fire incidents across Arizona. The incoming critical fire weather, which also includes dry thunderstorms, also means rapid fuel ignition and fire spread with very erratic and extreme fire behavior.

As of Friday, all state land within Arizona is under

Under Stage II, campfires and smoking outdoors is not allowed. Target shooting and fireworks are prohibited year-round. For private property owners, if working outdoors pay attention to the weather, avoid burning on windy days, and never leave a burn unattended. Have a water source and shovel nearby and use a spark arrester on equipment. Department of Forestry and Fire Management wildland fire investigators report multiple starts this year due to grinding and other equipment usage.

DFFM continues statewide prevention patrols with heavy focus on areas prone to ignitions. These areas include, the US-60 corridor from Wickenburg into Apache Junction, I-17 within the New River and Black Canyon City-areas, and I-10 through southern Arizona. Over the last few weeks, prevention officers have found multiple abandoned campfires and target shooting on state land. They have picked up a handful of roadside fires, responded to other fire starts, and have made dozens of proactive contacts

# Telegraph Fire proves relentless

The Telegraph Fire that started in the early afternoon of Friday, June 4, 2021, south of Superior in the Tonto National Forest has consumed 104,755 acres and at press time was 68 percent contained. There are more than 1,000 people fighting this fire. The fire lost some containment after the fire expanded aggressively Sunday night.

The fire has kept residents throughout the Copper Corridor on their toes as Set and Go evacuations orders were issued for Superior, Top of the World, Miami, Globe and on Monday, the areas of El Capitan and Dripping Springs were ordered to GO. Highway 60 between Superior and Miami reopened on Friday evening and Highway 177 reopened on Thursday morning. Highway 77 re-opened briefly, but was closed again on Sunday due to the expansion of the Telegraph fire.

At press time Superior, Miami and Globe have returned to Ready. Top of the World, and many of the canyons near the Pinal Mountains remain on Set.

As the fire traveled east through the Tonto National Forest it burned through the Pinal Mountains; and as the vegetation turned from Sonoran Desert to tall pines and manzanita the fire grew. Lack of humidity and high temperatures have not been in the favor of the crews fighting the fire. Speaker of the House, Rusty Bowers lost his cabin South of Pinto Valley and Rep. David Cook lost his vacation cabin in the Pinal Mountains. Over 20 structures have been lost, but there have been no significant injuries or deaths.

The fire and its footprint have been visited by Governor Doug Ducey, which followed a press conference where the Governor promised to call a special session of the legislature to address and provide funding for the communities affected by the Telegraph and Mescal fires. His speech focused on the needs of Gila County. Pinal County officials have said that the special session will also include support for the areas of Pinal County affected by the fire. Additional media reports have indicated the Governor is going to ask for \$100 million dollars for relief and recovery efforts. Mayor Mila Besich has declared an emergency to cover any recovery efforts the town may need to cover.

Senator Mark Kelly also visited the area and received in person briefings from the Incident Commands of the Telegraph and Mescal Fires. He also met with elected officials of Superior, Miami, Globe and San Carlos.

The Telegraph Fire has become one of the top 10 largest fires in Arizona's history. Copper Area News provides a variety of updates regarding the fire on our Facebook pages; residents can also follow the Telegraph Fire Incident Command Facebook page and website for additional information.

with the public.

To date, 848 wildfires have burned 208,190 acres statewide on all jurisdictions; state, federal, and tribal lands. In comparison to last year as of June 12, 907 wildfires burned 138,443 acres statewide.

"We cannot stress enough to the public the critical situation we are faced with. Firefighters are already challenged and any ignition starting within this droughtstricken fuel bed combined with our incoming critical fire weather could produce large, fast- moving and very active wildfires. Take personal responsibility, follow fire restrictions, and do your part with prevention efforts," said DFFM Fire Management Officer John Truett.

On Saturday, June 19, 2021, two trophy cases will be dedicated at San Manuel High School. The dedication ceremony will be at 10 a.m. at the foyer entrance at the San Manuel High School gymnasium. One trophy is dedicated to honor and remember Allen Ingram who was killed in Vietnam in 1968. The ceremony is open to the public and friends and family of Allen Ingram will be in attendance. The other trophy is dedicated to the San Manuel High School Class of 1967. Allen was a member of the Class of '67 as were Bob Acton, who donated the trophy cases, and others that helped along the way.

Bob Acton submitted the How and Why information on the trophy dedication to Allen Ingram. The story follows:

#### The Allen Ingram Trophy Case: Why and How

#### Our Trophy Case Project Team

Several people have been very helpful in this trophy case effort:

- Beth Acton: My spouse has made excellent suggestions, pushed me along when I needed it, and handled some nettlesome issues all the while singlehandedly arranging the move to our new primary residence in Dripping Springs, TX. Not giving up our beautiful house in Oro Valley, however. She also continues to make a good living, which allows me to do things like make trophy case donations.
- Frank Esparza: Though locked up in his independent living apartment not too far from our OV house, Frank, forever a U.S. Marine like Allen Ingram, has been an enthusiastic supporter and advisor since this whole

idea originated. Semper Fi, Frank.

- Tinker (John) Roybal: Tinker, our class pastor, has also provided support and counsel and has proven to be a good lunch companion at La Casita during my forays to San Manuel. Really fun talking with Tinker about working underground at the mine.
- Stephanie Beneitone: Stephanie came along a little later in the project, has given a lot of good advice, and has proven invaluable in getting things done regarding the trophy case dedication summary.

Couldn't have gotten where we are without a team effort.

#### Allen Ingram: a Great Friend and a Great Person

Allen Ingram became my friend when our family returned from Tucson to the San Manuel area at the end of 1961 when I was in 7th grade. I had become friends with Chuck Tiller, who lived close to the Ingram family on lower 4th Ave, and I came to know Allen and his family through Chuck.

Over the course of the years between then and the end of high school I enjoyed getting to know Allen and his parents, Cliff and Bonnie, and developed a great fondness for all of them. Allen was their only child and they doted on him.

One of my favorite memories of Allen was Boy Scout camp in the Catalina Mountains one August. We spent a week in a pup tent enduring torrential rains every evening while sharing our space with a family of skunks living underneath our wooden tent platform.

What you can say about Allen is that he was a

genuinely nice person who was fun to be around, but he would take you down in football practice in a decidedly unfriendly way.

I've always felt sadness not only about his untimely death but also about the fact that he was his parents' only child. Their grief at his loss must have been unimaginable.

#### Long-time Thoughts **About a Donation to SMHS** in Honor of **Allen Ingram**

For many years I had wanted to make a contribution to San Manuel High School in honor of Allen. My problem lay in finding the right vehicle. A scholarship wasn't appropriate in my view because Allen was not an academically oriented person, he liked sports. Nothing else really came to mind, however, and there the matter lingered for many years with nothing happening to motivate me to act.

#### **Trophy Case** Inspiration

Then lightning struck late last summer in the form of the misbegotten "trophygate" incident at SMHS. Sondra, a cashier at our local Oro Valley Safeway who is from San Manuel, asked me if I had heard the news about San Manuel High School. Of course I hadn't because I don't follow the local news and I don't do Facebook. Totally in the dark I was. What I got from Sondra was that the school had thrown out a large number of trophies and that the community was in an uproar about it.

Checking things out on the web, I quickly found a video of Julie Dale-Scott, the School Superintendent, fishing trophies out of a Waste Management dumpster surrounded by an angry mob of local

citizens. Quite a sight. There were also lots of videos and comments on the web expressing outrage over the school's behavior - justifiable outrage I might add. Plenty of outrage but nothing constructive suggested as a remedy.


Then it struck me - why not donate a trophy case to the school in honor of Allen? Perfect. Allen loved sports, as you know, and he would sure like his name being attached to something involving athletics, something like a trophy case. A whole lot better than a scholarship in his mind, no doubt. There it was: a win-win solution in which a remedy for SMHS's trophy fiasco would be a gift in honor of Allen.

#### The Trophy Case Plan

The approach I decided upon was to commission Mark Wilson, a master craftsman who did the beautiful cabinet work in our Oro Valley house, to produce a trophy case to be given in Allen's honor to SMHS. Budget: \$10K. I proposed this as an in-kind donation to the school with the proviso that the trophy case be dedicated in honor of Allen Ingram. The offer was accepted, and I contracted with Mark to construct the trophy case. This was in October.

We had expected the trophy case to be completed and installed by the end of December, but Mark ran into serious delays in securing certain specialized aluminum components needed to frame what I thought was one trophy case. It then turned out that we were getting two trophy cases for \$10k, not one.

I had consulted about the trophy donation from the beginning with Tinker Roybal and Frank Esparza,

but when the second trophy case materialized, I contacted Stephanie Beneitone about whom we might honor with the second trophy case, a fortuitous move as it has turned out.

After a couple of naming missteps, Stephanie and I determined to simply dedicate the second case to ourselves, SMHS Class of 1967. Frank and Tinker were okay with that idea, and that's where we ended up. The two memorial plaques are simple, with a copper surface, and Julie Dale-Scott has the one made for Allen. The

SMHS Class of 1967 plaque supposedly exists, but I can't seem to get it into my possession.

#### **Trophy Cases** Installation

Two trophy cases, which had materialized from one, were installed by Mark Wilson and his crew in April.

Now we have two beautiful trophy cases residing in the trophy case area adjacent to the San Manuel gym. They are constructed with maple and aluminum, and they're illuminated. They're also big - about 1.5 times bigger than the surrounding cases. They definitely stand out.

#### **Dedication Ceremony**

Now we're on to the dedication ceremony. Stephanie has really helped out by contacting the Ingram family, of whom we expect nine at the dedication. She's also developed a good working relationship with Julie Dale-Scott's administrative assistant, Mandy Renteria. This has helped a lot in terms of dealing with the mechanics involved in conducting the actual dedication ceremony. And, of course, Stephanie is working with you, which has been all to the good.
