

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APS offering grants to Arizona teachers through 'Supply My Class' program; K-12 Title 1 Arizona public, charter schoolteachers can apply for \$500 grant

San Manuel Senior Center slated for repairs

Pinal County recently announced to the public that it plans to utilize Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to make needed repairs and improve handicapped accessibility to the San Manuel Senior Center.

When BHP shuttered the mining operations in 1992, they allowed some of the community buildings and facilities to be used by the public. Recently BHP worked with Pinal County to divest some of their facilities and community infrastructure to the county. Local volunteers kept the facility and activities functioning but larger maintenance projects were not always possible.

The CDBG funding, once allocated by Pinal County, will be used to improve the parking lot, add new lighting to the building, replace kitchen cabinets and replace drywall. Focus is being given to ensuring the building has improved ADA accessibility.

CDBG funds are distributed across the United States and are used to help support projects that improve the infrastructure and community development in low to moderate income communities.

Those who attend and frequent the Senior Center in San Manuel are excited about the upcoming upgrades to their beloved facility.
