men of their blood can be hanged." It pointed out that four "Americans" had been saved, two by

commutation and two by insanity proceedings. "Of the 16 condemned men, only Mexicans had been hanged." They claimed racial discrimination and "complained that the authorities do not go to so great a length to save men of Mexican blood." On July 7, 1916, Miguel Peralta, another Mexican was hanged. The November elections

of 1916 resulted in Governor Hunt losing to Thomas E. Campbell. The death penalty was also abolished by Arizona's voters although those condemned prisoners sentenced before the new law would still be subject to execution including William Faltin. On Dec. 30, 1916, Faltin escaped from the Arizona State Asylum for the Insane. A \$100 reward was offered for his capture. He would be caught a few days later in Buckeye, Arizona. In August 1917, Faltin was discharged from the state asylum and found to be sane. He was returned

to Arizona State Prison in Florence. Governor Campbell said he would commute Faltin's sentence to life in prison.

Governor Campbell was embroiled in a legal fight to keep the position of Governor. He had won the election by a mere 30 votes. Governor Hunt had refused to leave his position as Governor and had filed legal actions claiming that the election had been fraudulent. In December 1917, the Arizona Supreme Court determined there were election irregularities and declared Hunt the winner of the election. Campbell would have to leave office Dec. 25, 1917. He never acted on the commutation for Faltin.

In 1918, petitions were filed by a pro-death penalty group to allow the voters of Arizona to again vote on capital punishment. They argued that 85 murders had occurred in the state since the death penalty had been abolished while there had been 36 while the death penalty was law. It cited several murder cases including Faltin's, a case of a young child murdered by a Yaqui Indian and Star Daly who murdered a man, kidnapped and raped the man's wife. Daly was taken from sheriff's deputies and lynched by vigilantes in Pinal County. It said that reinstating the death penalty would prevent



more lynchings.

Another case that may have tipped the scale in the election was the murders of Graham County Sheriff McBride and his two deputies by the Power brothers, Tom and John, and Tom Sisson in a shootout in the Galiuro Mountains in February 1918. Tom Campbell was running for Governor again against Hunt. Campbell now said he was for the death penalty although he admitted that he had been against the death penalty previously due to his ignorance.

Proposition 306 reinstating the death penalty passed in November. Tom Campbell defeated Hunt for

newspapers began reporting that Faltin was due to be executed. An execution was scheduled for April 17, 1920 but it wasn't Faltin. Simplicio Torres had been convicted and sentenced to death in August 1919. Despite an attempt by the editor of the Spanish language newspaper Justicia presenting evidence that Torres may be insane, no insanity hearing was

held and Torres was hanged.

In 1923, Faltin filed a plea with the Board of Pardons and Parole. Faltin's request said, "Either hang me or commute my sentence to life imprisonment and end the terrible suspense of uncertainty." No attempt had been made to execute Faltin since the death penalty had been reinstated. Eight men had been hanged

since then, six of them Mexicans. They had all been sentenced after Faltin. The board did not act on Faltin's request.

John. The Power brothers were also trustees and serving life sentences. They had walked away and were presumed to be headed for Mexico.

Ten days later the Power brothers were captured near San Luis, Mexico. They informed officers that they believed that Faltin had drowned trying to cross the Colorado River in a raft. Had nature done what the hangman couldn't? Arizona and Mexican authorities searched for 10 hours along the river but no sign

of Faltin was found. On Jan. 10, 1940, Faltin was captured at El Dokor, Sonora about 42 miles south of the U.S. border. Faltin was returned to the prison

in Florence and placed inside the walls. The Arizona Republic stated that "Death once more has lost to the Old Man." On Jan. 15, 1953, after spending 39 years in prison

and at the age of 78, William Faltin died. The newspapers reported that Faltin was "Freed by death."


