



# Academic Gains in the Oracle Elementary School District



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## Meet Your Pinal County Supervisor: Jeff McClure

Every 10 years after the official US Census is complete, Federal State and Local governments must complete a re-districting process. On July 1, 2022 the Pinal County re-districting took affect and the communities of San Manuel, Oracle and Mammoth joined Supervisor District 4 which is represented by Supervisor Jeff McClure.

McClure served on the Oracle Elementary School Governing Board and also as a precinct committeeman prior to running for the Board of Supervisors. Originally his district included the bulk of Maricopa and the SaddleBrooke communities and Oracle, San Manuel and Mammoth were in District 1, which included Superior and Kearny. The new redistricting split the Copper Corridor region in eastern Pinal County and now Superior and Kearny are in district five with Apache Junction and Gold Canyon.

McClure is currently serving as the Chairperson for the Board of Supervisors. He is keenly focussed on the business and budgeting practices at Pinal County.

"Improving the budget and business services is a priority," he explained.

Understanding the budget and making sure that the departments have the funding and personnel to run efficiently is important to him. This was also a leadership role he took during his board service at the Oracle Elementary School District and they found ways to fund projects and improve things.

With a focus on business process and budgeting, he determined that his supervisor's budget did not need to fund the work of the other county departments. Working with the public works department they have figured out a

are recovering academically from the impact of the global pandemic.

As you can see, our 4th graders outperformed the state average in the area of mathematics and our 8th graders outperformed the state average in the areas of reading and writing. Our 8th graders were also one point away from the state average mathematics score. In the areas we did not outperform the state average, as you can see, we are not far behind. We attribute our academic growth to the following five attributes of our school district:

- 1. Our extraordinary teachers and staff who truly care about our students. Our teachers differentiate instruction and meet students where they are academically. We provide support for students during the school day as well as after-school. Our after-school support programs are funded by generous tax credit donations from our community.
- Our hardworking students who want to succeed and work to meet and exceed their personal academic goals.
   Our Governing Board and their support and adoption of research-based academic curriculum that is rigorous, relevant, and meets the expectations for student learning as outlined in the Arizona College and Career Readiness Standards.
- 4. Our staff that works to make sure we keep our campus clean, our facilities safe, our families informed, and our students are cared for. This includes our food service staff that makes sure students are not hungry at school, our maintenance and custodial teams, our bus drivers that transport students to school and back home, our mechanic that keeps our school buses in tip-top shape, and our office staff that makes sure we apply for additional grant funding, hire the most qualified staff members, maintain accurate records, and provide classroom teachers with the resources they need to do their jobs.
- 5. Our incredible school community of families and caring neighbors. During the pandemic, community groups came together to make sure our students had the resources they needed to be successful. The Oracle Schools Foundation provided funding for internet hot spots so students in rural areas or without a strong

internet connection could still engage in their online schoolwork. SaddleBrooke Community Outreach continued to provide clothing and necessities for students in need through their Kids' Closet and Teens' Closet programs.

As you can see, academic growth is a team effort. While we took a moment to celebrate our academic growth, we also know we have more work to do. Our students are exceptional, and we know they can outperform the state averages in all grade levels, across all content areas. Our new school year started on Aug. 4, and we immediately

jumped in and started teaching and learning. We have not opened our campus for many volunteers over the past couple years because of the pandemic. We look forward to welcoming our volunteers back. We also look forward to further developing our Gifted Education Program and continuing to take our learning off campus and into the community for valuable, educational field trips.




