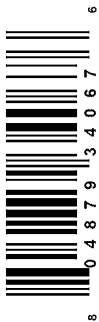

ADOT to drivers: More monsoon storms require extra caution; be prepared, stay alert for wet highways, possible flooding and debris

PHOENIX – With the National Weather Service forecasting additional monsoon storms in Arizona, drivers should exercise extreme caution and consider ways to avoid severe conditions on the state's highways and roads. That includes delaying travel until severe weather has passed.

The National Weather Service has noted that wet ground conditions already exist from recent rain, allowing for more rapid flash flooding from new storms this week. With the ground heavily saturated, even small storms have added potential to produce flash flooding or other dangerous conditions. Runoff from storms can send debris, including large rocks or boulders, onto highways and local roads.

The Arizona Department of Transportation says drivers should pay attention to weather forecasts. Monsoon weather can produce thunderstorms with sudden, heavy rainfall. As has already been experienced this summer, areas where wildfires have burned in recent years are vulnerable to

debris flows. Nighttime driving can be especially risky due to reduced visibility. Keep these tips in mind:

- Don't risk crossing a flooded wash, even if it doesn't look deep. Even a few inches of running water poses a serious risk.
- Stay alert in areas prone to falling rocks. Remember, runoff can loosen rocks and boulders from slopes above roadways.
- Don't drive around "Road Closed" signs. You risk your life and face being cited under state law.
- If traffic lights are out, treat an intersection as a four-way stop.
- Inspect your windshield wipers and replace them if necessary.
- Reduce your speed and maintain a safe distance between your vehicle and the one in front of you.
- Avoid sudden braking, which can cause you to slide on wet pavement. To slow down, take your foot off the gas pedal and brake slowly.

Other safety tips for driving in rainstorms are available at azdot.gov/monsoons.

Drivers also should remain prepared for dust storms during summer monsoon weather. Avoid driving into a dust storm. In almost no time, blowing dust can drop visibility to zero, especially where small dust channels afford drivers little or no opportunity to avoid this hazard. Here are other dust storm safety tips:

- If you encounter a dust storm, immediately check traffic

around your vehicle (front, back and to the side) and begin slowing down.

- Don't wait until poor visibility makes it difficult to pull off the roadway safely; do it as soon as possible. Completely exit the highway if you can.

San Manuel Jr. High students on remote learning after exposure to COVID-19

Parents of sixth through eighth graders at Mammoth-San Manuel PK-12 School were notified over the weekend that students would be temporarily moving to remote learning through Aug. 23.

Julie Dale-Scott, school superintendent, released the following statement on Facebook:

“It has come to our attention that we have a positive case in the junior high. Through careful consideration with Pinal County Health, we have decided it best to quarantine all 6 through 8 grade students through, Monday, Aug. 23, 2021. This means that there will not be any junior high students on the campus starting tomorrow, Monday, Aug. 16 except for Chromebook pickup. All junior high students will be doing distance learning through Google Classrooms and their regular

Mammoth-San Manuel teachers starting Tuesday, Aug. 17, through Monday, Aug. 23 and will return to in-person school, pending they do not test positive or have symptoms, on Tuesday, Aug. 24, 2021.”

Dale-Scott assured parents that all areas of the campus have been treated and that the school district was being “cautious” by quarantining the whole junior high student body.

“All junior high students should be quarantining at this time and checking daily for symptoms. They should be staying home and checking their temperatures twice daily while watching for other symptoms of COVID. Junior High students, IF VACCINATED, should not get tested for COVID until Aug. 16 or 17. Junior High students, if NOT VACCINATED, should not get tested for COVID until August 18 or 19. Testing for COVID prior to these dates could cause a false negative,” the school’s statement continued.

“Junior High students may come back to in-person schooling Tuesday, Aug. 24, IF and ONLY IF they have not shown symptoms of COVID or have been tested negative.

Recently, State and National media have reported an increase in positive COVID-19 Cases. The communities of the Copper Corridor have also started to see an increase in positive cases. The new Delta variant of COVID-19 has been reported as highly transmissible. The CDC and other health officials warn that those who are not vaccinated should continue to practice physical distancing, wear masks in public and avoid crowded places and is also strongly recommending everyone wear a mask indoors and in group settings.


Governor Doug Ducey has signed executive orders that prohibit Cities and Towns from mandating mask wearing, limiting restaurant capacity or other enacting other physical distancing requirements. At this time there is no indication that there will be any restrictions put into place. Local schools are also prohibited from requiring masks be worn on campus.

COVID Vaccines are readily available at local clinics in the region including Cobre Valley Clinics in Superior and Kearny, Pinal County Public Health and Sun Life Clinics. Other chain pharmacies such as Walgreens, grocery store pharmacies and CVS also have vaccines available.

We last reported daily COVID-19 case increased on July 26, 2021. Below is a chart showing our last reported number and the current number of total cases for each of the Copper Corridor communities. Keep in mind that zip code data also includes unincorporated areas around a community. For instance, Riverside/Kelvin area is included in the Kearny zip code. Aravaipa and Dudleyville are included in the Winkelman zip codes, etc.

Those experiencing COVID-19 symptoms should seek testing and quarantine until they can confirm a negative test.

Working together, we can slow the spread of the virus across the Copper Corridor. Wear a mask in public, remain physically distant (6ft apart or more), practice good hygiene (wash your hands frequently, sanitize high touch areas) and stay home if you are not feeling well.

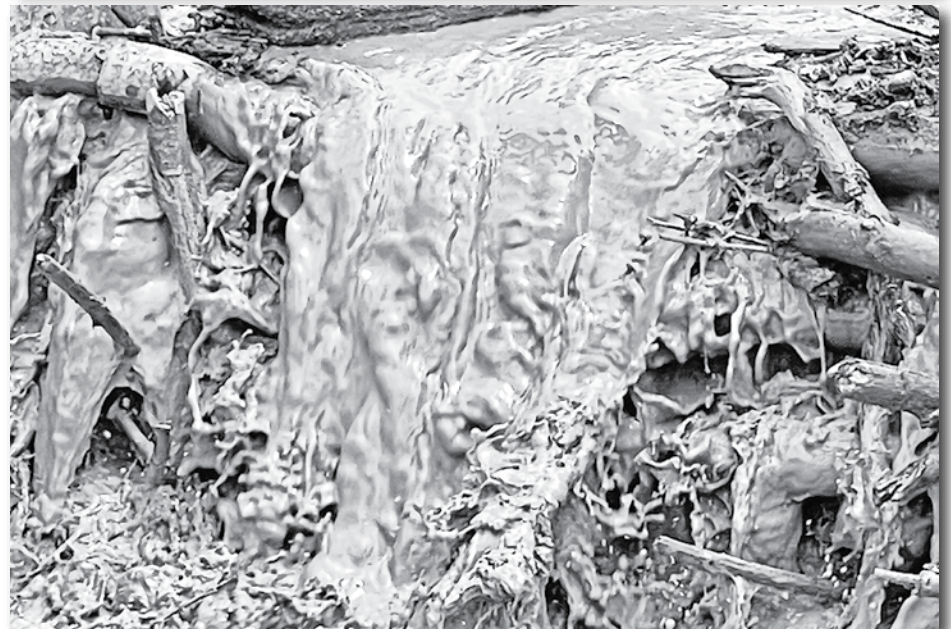

ADOT smooths process for school bus drivers to report stop sign violators; drivers reminded to stop when children are boarding, exiting school bus

PHOENIX – With school buses prowling through neighborhoods again as school resumes, drivers should expect to wait when the bus's stop sign arm is extended while children are boarding and exiting the bus. However, about 13,000 motorists each year are reported by Arizona school bus drivers for not stopping as required.

A new streamlined process is allowing the Arizona Department of Transportation Motor Vehicle Division to send warning letters more quickly to owners of vehicles that were reported as not stopping for the school bus stop sign.

Using an online form, bus drivers can send a complaint of a stop sign violator directly to ADOT's Motor Vehicle Division. MVD then sends a notification letter, which is not a citation, to the vehicle owner as an effort to call attention to the seriousness of running the stop sign, which allows students getting on and off the bus a safe space to cross the street.

Previously, school bus drivers would fax forms to the Arizona Department of Public Safety, which then emailed or faxed the reports to MVD.

"Oftentimes, the reports were in batches and difficult to read, and it put DPS in the middle," said MVD Senior Division Administrator Susan Trask. "We created an online form for the bus drivers to complete, removing DPS completely from the process, and making the submission electronic. This removed the need to fill out a form to fax or email."

Motorists, who are issued citations by law enforcement officers for passing a school bus when a stop arm is extended, could face a civil penalty and possibly a suspended driver license under state law.

- Don't stop in a travel lane or in the emergency lane. Look for a safe place to pull completely off the paved portion of the roadway.
- Turn off all vehicle lights, including your emergency flashers. You don't want other vehicles approaching from behind to use your lights as a guide and crash into your vehicle.
- Set your emergency brake and take your foot off the brake.
- Stay in the vehicle with your seat belt buckled and wait for the storm to pass.
- Drivers of high-profile vehicles should be aware of changing weather conditions and reduce speed.

From the Pinal County Health Department: Help Prevent Mosquito Related Illness

During seasonal mosquito surveillance the Pinal County Public Health Services District (PCPHSD) has continued to detect West Nile Virus (WNV) positive mosquitoes in the county. Mosquito surveillance is done throughout Pinal County in order to determine the relative risk of mosquito-borne disease to the community. We are currently moving into a higher risk period for transmission of WNV.

Chris Reimus, who manages Pinal County's Environmental Health Division, said, "Mosquitoes are a part of our desert environment, just like the sun. People are used to avoiding sunburns and wearing sunscreen; the same principles apply to mosquitoes. Avoid them and wear CDC recommended repellent if mosquitoes cannot be avoided."

Things that you can do to help stop breeding of disease carrying mosquitoes and prevent mosquito bites:

- Eliminate standing water where mosquitoes can lay their eggs.
- Be sure your property is graded to drain appropriately.
- Change water in flower vases, birdbaths, planters, troughs, and animal watering pans at least twice a week. Be sure to scrub them out when changing water.

- Get rid of junk or debris in your yard that can collect water.
- Repair leaky pipes and faucets.
- If you have a swimming pool or backyard pond, keep it operational. If you must keep it out of use, make sure you remove the standing water, keep it chlorinated, or run the filter daily.
- Keep mosquitoes outside of your home by having well-fitting screens on both windows and doors.
- Use Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)-registered insect repellents with one of the active ingredients:

DEET, picaridin, IR3535, oil of lemon eucalyptus (OLE), para-menthane-diol (PMD), or 2-undecanone.

- When using sunscreen, always apply the sunscreen before you apply the insect repellent.

West Nile virus is the leading cause of mosquito-borne disease in the continental United States. It is most commonly spread to people by the bite of an infected mosquito. Cases of WNV occur during mosquito season, which starts in the summer and continues through fall. There are no vaccines to prevent or medications to treat WNV in people.

Fortunately, most people infected with WNV do not feel sick. About 1 in 5 people who are infected develop a fever and other symptoms. About 1 out of 150 infected people develop a serious, sometimes fatal, illness. Symptoms of WNV such as rash on the trunk, headaches, high fever, neck stiffness or disorientation, may look like other health conditions. Always seek diagnosis and treatment from a medical provider.

Pinal County also investigates complaints related to disease causing mosquitoes, such as permanent standing water, green pools, or other
