Approximately 300 rural leaders from across Arizona gathered in Miami-Globe for the 16th Annual Rural Policy Forum. The forum is hosted each August usually in a rural community.

Attendees were treated to dinner events that showcased the unique local flair and foods of the region. During the

Thursday evening event, the Superior Dance Company performed at the Cobre Valley Recreational Center in Miami.

During the conference State Representative David Cook (Globe), spoke and welcomed all of the participants and shared how he is working at the legislature to be an

Recently Governor Katie Hobbs announced that Arizona would be receiving almost \$1 billion from the Federal government to improve high speed internet access across the state of Arizona. From the metro areas to the most remote locations of rural Arizona, this funding will be the most significant investment to-date.

Ensuring that the funding is spent to benefit all reaches of Arizona, the Digital Equity Institute and the Arizona Department of Commerce are conducting a survey for Arizona residents and business owners and organizations to fill out. He stated to the crowd that Arizona's elections are not rigged. “If they were rigged, then why would I have been elected?” he said.

He also shared information on his recent visit to the Ukraine with a delegation of non-elected leaders from Arizona stressing the importance of Arizona increasing their international relationships to grow our economy.

Cook also spoke about how important public schools are in rural Arizona and how the needs in Maricopa County are not the same as rural Arizona.

Todd Pryor, Town Manager of Superior, was also invited to speak about the Town of Superior's success utilizing brownfields grants from the Arizona Department of

Environmental Quality. Pryor also spoke about the work of the Copper Communities Blight Busters program that is funded by an EPA region 9 grant.

The conference included plenty of time for networking and learning. This year there was a focus on strategic planning for communities and organizations.

The Superior Chamber of Commerce, Town of Superior, Rebuild Superior Inc., Superior Food Bank and Boyce Thompson Arboretum all had attendees at the event. Resolution Copper provided scholarships for many of the local attendees from Superior. The Copper Corridor Economic Development Coalition also had attendees at the event.
