

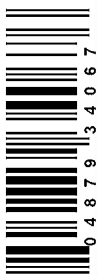

Reminder: US 60 to close Sept. 12-17 between Superior and Miami; crews will work 24 hours a day to shift highway to new bridge

Motorists who travel on US 60 between Superior and Miami need to begin planning for a full closure of the highway from Sept. 12-17 while crews with the Arizona

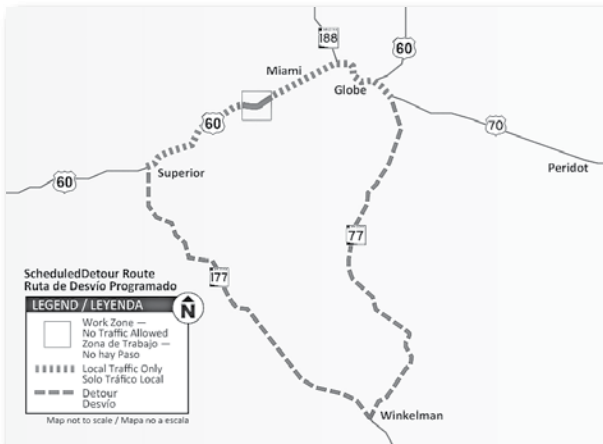
Department of Transportation realign the roadway to meet with the new Pinto Creek bridge.

During the 5-day closure, motorists should expect an extra hour of travel and a 10 percent grade as traffic is detoured onto state routes 77 and 177 through Winkelman. Eastbound traffic in Superior will be directed onto SR 177, and westbound traffic will be redirected at the west end of Miami.

Motorists with a destination in the closed segment of US 60 will be allowed to pass the closure points, but no vehicles will be allowed between Top-of-the-World and Pinto Valley Mine Road.

The closure is scheduled to begin at 10 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 12, and end at noon Friday, Sept. 17. The closure is subject to change based on weather.

While ADOT has worked to minimize the impact of the bridge replacement project, the extended closure is required because of the work involved with shifting the highway roughly 30 feet while also raising it 8 feet to align with the new structure. Crews will work 24 hours

Recently, State and National media have reported an increase in positive COVID-19 Cases. The communities of the Copper Corridor have also started to see an increase in positive cases. The new Delta variant of COVID-19 has been reported as highly transmissible. The CDC and other health officials warn that those who are not vaccinated should continue to practice physical distancing, wear masks in public and avoid crowded places and is also strongly recommending everyone wear a mask indoors and in group settings.

Governor Doug Ducey has signed executive orders that prohibit Cities and Towns from mandating mask wearing, limiting restaurant capacity or other enacting other physical distancing requirements. At this time there is no indication that there will be any restrictions put into place. Local schools are also prohibited from requiring masks be worn on campus.

COVID Vaccines are readily available at local clinics in the region including Cobre Valley Clinics in Superior and Kearny, Pinal County Public Health and Sun Life Clinics. Other chain pharmacies such as Walgreens, grocery store pharmacies and CVS also have vaccines available.

We last reported daily COVID-19 case increased on Aug. 31, 2021. Above is a chart showing our last reported number and the current number of total cases for each of the Copper Corridor communities through Sept. 6, 2021. Keep in mind that zip code data also includes unincorporated areas around a community. For instance, Riverside/Kelvin area is included in the Kearny zip code. Aravaipa and Dudleyville are included in the Winkelman zip codes, etc.

Those experiencing COVID-19 symptoms should seek testing and quarantine until they can confirm a negative test.

Working together, we can slow the spread of the virus across the Copper Corridor. Wear a mask in public, remain physically distant (6ft apart or more), practice good hygiene (wash your hands frequently, sanitize high touch areas) and stay home if you are not feeling well.

to receive needed renovation through county CDBG funds

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. Construction at the the Lionel D. Ruiz Park in Dudleyville and the San Manuel community park behind the San Manuel Community Center will begin soon.

Two Pinal County parks in the Copper Corridor are getting some much needed revitalization thanks to the county's

Pinal County Space and Trails Director, Kent Taylor, offered some insight to Copper Area News as to the park renovations.

Dudleyville's park has been receiving incremental improvements since 2013, most being ADA compliance work. As for the San Manuel community park, it wasn't until 2019 that the park was taken over from BHP by Pinal County. The county then did an assessment of the San Manuel park, discovering that it showed a lot of age. Pinal County has also been assessing the park with help from community voices.

Bidding for the San Manuel Park project began in 2020, but the county discovered that it was going to be more expensive than anticipated. The county was able to find additional funding through grants. BHP agreed to provide demolition, and some seed funding as well. In the end

the county found out it would be easier to package both parks together as one project.

There wasn't much that could be salvaged from the SM Park. Most playground equipment was removed from the grounds. The old basketball court was taken out, and the fencing around the old tennis courts were also removed.

The Dudleyville park will mostly be receiving ADA updates, such as handicap parking, accessible walkways, and playground accessibility improvements. It will also get basketball court improvements.

"We've put a lot of focus on it since 2013," Kent Taylor commented on the Dudleyville park, "a lot of concern on preventative maintenance, and keeping it up to high standards."

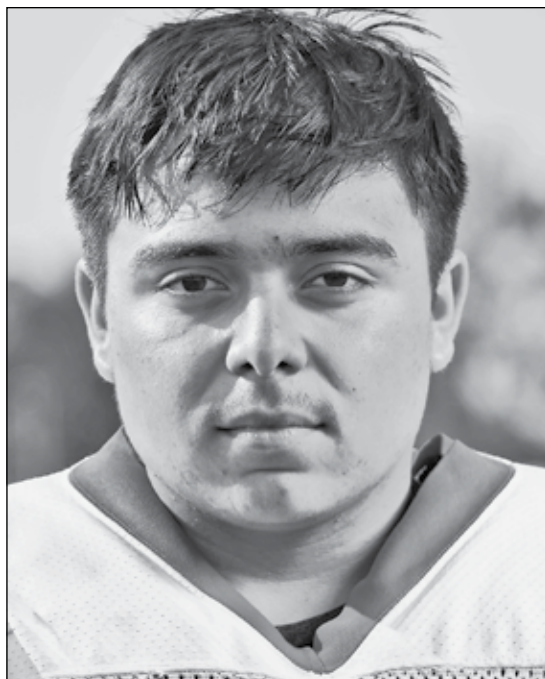

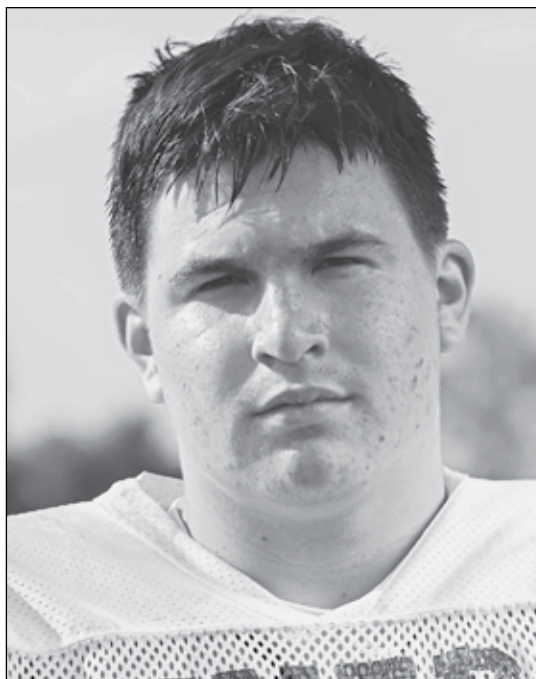

Last Friday, the San Manuel football team hosted the Duncan Wildkats – a close game that ended up in overtime, with both teams in a 0-0 stalemate until the fifth quarter.

The Miners were down three starting linemen, but didn't let that keep them from holding down Duncan's

defense. San Manuel was aware that they were up against an aggressive tackling team. Duncan was able to suppress the Miner's offense for the first four quarters.

With zero points on the scoreboard for either team, San Manuel had to pick it up in overtime and pick it up they did thanks to quarterback Nico Velasquez who threw for 288 yards, and 4 touchdowns. The Miners turned up the heat and posted 38 points in the fifth quarter, resulting in their 38-8 victory over Duncan.

"A lot of the players stepped it up when it was time. I'm very proud of them," commented head coach Ernie Ivy. "Our next game is with Superior. They are down this year, but we can't take them lightly, playing them at home. They have a big front line and some athletic kids. We need to work on downfield blocking and tune up our running game."

The Miners now hold a 2-0 record, and will work to continue their winning streak Friday, Sept. 10, at the Superior football field, with a kick-off time of 7 p.m.

Peeking at wildlife and stars and other Oracle State Park events

A representative of Friends of Oracle State Park (FOSP) stated, "Record monsoon rain has made Oracle State Park more beautiful than ever this summer. Colorful morning glory vines abound, and every species of plant is blooming. Please visit the park soon! You might have to dodge the many butterflies who are enjoying the celebration."

Besides the usual draws of a walk through nature, there are some exciting events planned for the enjoyment of Oracle State Park, whether the event is meant for a pleasurable outing or a means of increasing functionality.

On the functional side, a

well-designed blind helps visitors to Oracle State Park enjoy viewing wildlife creatures without disturbing them. Unfortunately, the old blind has deteriorated to the point where its form no longer follows its function. Fear not! FOSP has clearance from State Park management to build a new blind.

The plan is to create a sturdy, long lasting structure at the old location and utilizing the existing low wall and stone work. The blind is planned as an 8-foot by 8-foot structure of roughhewn beams and fabricated brackets and hardware, created by local artisan Troy Letwak. The roof

will consist of peeled pole latillas, with a viewing area created by woven manzanita stick craft. The cost for contractor, Stephen Booth, to demolish the old blind and build the new blind is estimated to be \$15,000. A campaign is in the works to raise funds for the building of this new wildlife blind.

A representative of FOSP stated, "We are embarking on a capital campaign to raise these funds. We have already received a donation of \$1334 from an anonymous FOSP member! In addition, FOSP members Ronald and Jacquelyn Feller, are offering a matching challenge toward our goal! They will generously match your donation toward the Wildlife Blind Fund, dollar for dollar, up to \$5,000."

a day during the closure.

The work that will take place during the closure represents a major milestone in the two-year, \$22.7 million project to replace the 72-year-old bridge. Once traffic is shifted onto the nearly 700-foot long bridge,

construction crews will begin the process of removing the old structure and restoring the project site.

Also, drivers should expect a 4-hour closure in October when crews take down the old bridge. Through the rest of the year, occasional lane

restrictions will be required as crews haul away remnants of the old bridge and complete other roadway improvements.
